

What makes an insulin pen smart¹?

NovoPen[®] 6 is a smart¹ insulin pen. What makes it smart¹ is that it records your insulin dosing information automatically, so you don't have to note it down yourself. And the pen allows you to easily check information about your last dose, so you don't have to worry about remembering it.

You can transfer this information to your preferred compatible app^{*}, allowing you to view your dosing information alongside glucose information from your Blood Glucose Monitor or Continuous Glucose Monitor (if you are using one). Plus, all of this information can be shared with your healthcare provider or family members, if you wish.
